Talk Saves Lives: An Introduction to Suicide Prevention

Kat Olbrich, a director of Maryland & Delaware Area at American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (AFSP), began her presentation, sharing a short video of Christine Moutier, a Chief Medical Officer at the AFSP, and her message on the COVID-19 related to suicide.

Ms. Olbrich encouraged members to use and share the Mental Health and COVID-19 online materials available on the AFSP and the Psych Hub to promote community education.

Kat Olbrich presented *Talk Saves Lives*, to the coalition members and listed several effective ways for them to maintain their healthy mental status during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Amy Miller, a Lead Clinician at Grassroots Mobile Crisis Team, delivered her presentation about the suicide assessment and the safety planning in response to the COVID-19.

Ms. Miller also shared several safety plans to reduce possible suicide/suicidal trials among people at high risk of suicide, stressing that the most significant and effective way, especially during this the COVID-19 pandemic, is to maintain human interaction/communication.
