Ms. Smoley shared additional key modifications that have been made in order to continue the aforementioned services in response to the coronavirus outbreak. For example, most of the programs were offered in-person, if needed, after an initial assessment by phone. Also, Ms. Smoley stated that Grassroots has been working closely with Humanim and Howard County Dept. of Corrections to ensure that residents in shelter are getting their needs met during the COVID-19 pandemic.
