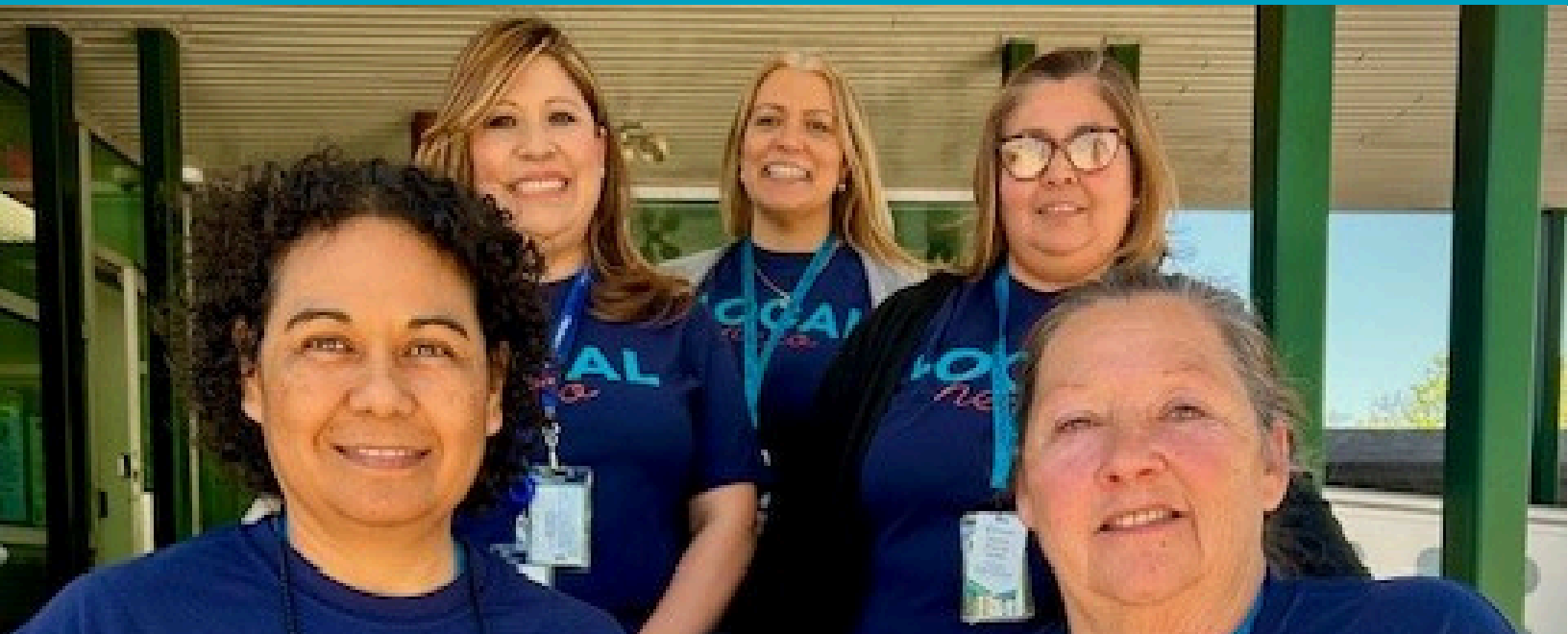


Meet Your Community Health Worker Team
