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
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

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
SCOPE OF THE PROBLEM Suicide was the leading cause of death for youth ages 15-19 in Howard County between 2014-2016 1 in 6 high school students & 1 in 5 middle school students seriously considered attempting suicide. The number of young children & adolescents admitted to hospitals for thoughts of suicide or self-harm more than doubled from 2008 - 2015 SUICIDE IS PREVENTABLE! 



