Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Study	Lauren Williams briefly shared the outcomes from a recent study published by the Robert Wood Johnson which shows significant gaps in life expectancy that persists across many United States cities and towns. The website allows you to enter an address/zip code to see life expectancy comparisons at the County, State, and national levels. The study encourages us to explore how life expectancy in America compares with life expectancy in various community areas to help everyone have the opportunity to live a longer and healthier life. According to the website, the life expectancy is 78.80 in East Howard County compared to 84.90 in Central Howard County.
