Presentation(s)	The following presentations were made: HCLHIC Updates: Reena Rambharat, HCLHIC Director, Howard County Health Department, reviewed the HCLHIC Strategic Plan, Current Projects, and Workgroups. The following are the three main HCLHIC priorities for FY2022-2025: Healthy Beginnings to prevent and care for gestational diabetes, maternal and child health and pediatric obesity Healthy Living Priority to prevent Chronic disease and to increase physical activity and healthier food and beverage choices. Healthy Minds Priority to decrease social isolation and support mental health. Ms. Rambharat reviewed the five new groups convened by the HCHD/HCLHIC and partners. Health Literacy Advisory Committee Food Security Committee Movement Group Chronic Disease Prevention & Management Group Healthy Minds & Suicide Prevention Coalition Groups will be formed as needed to address the priorities including those related to maternal and child health. Healthy Lifestyle in Residential Communities Project

A \$50,000 CareFirst Grant was awarded to the HCLHIC on National Health Equity. This grant addresses diabetes and other chronic diseases in HOCO. The HCHD and HCLHIC are piloting an initiative to engage residential communities in strategies to promote physical activity, healthy eating, and connecting community members to resources that support these preventative health measures.

Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Dental Coverage for Adults

Charlotte Hager, MPH, CHES, Dental Collaborative Director, Maryland Dental Action Coalition (MDAC), spoke about the following Adult Dental Pilot (ADP) Program updates including:

- A. Howard County ADP Data
- B. Legislation updates: On May 12, 2022,
 Governor Hogan signed legislation
 establishing Medicaid adult dental
 coverage. Services will be available to all

- adults over the age of 21 effective January 1, 2023.
- C. Medical Dental Coverage for Adults: Reimbursement rate increase of 9.5% effective July 1, 2022.
- D. Postpartum Coverage Extended: Effective April 1, 2022, Medicaid-eligible pregnant individuals can access full Medicaid benefits for the duration of their pregnancy and the 12-month postpartum period.
- E. MDAC ADP Program Social Media Campaign: Community-focused campaign to continue efforts to engage, educate, and encourage ADP-eligible (dual-eligible) adults to connect with dental care in their area.
- F. Medicaid Adult Dental Initiatives.

Tobacco Engagement Grantee Panel

Connie Ford, BSN, RN, Cancer Prevention and Control Program Supervisor, Access to Healthcare Bureau, Howard County Health Department spoke about the HCHD Tobacco / Vaping Use Prevention Grant. The HCHD was awarded \$15,000 in grants to five local organizations to assist with tobacco/vaping use prevention, education, and cessation outreach efforts, with specific emphasis on populations/groups identified as at risk or having a known health disparity related to tobacco.

Grantees awarded:

- 1. Accessible Resources for Independence Campaign for Tobacco-Free Disability Community will promote and provide referral to smoking cessation resources and services for individuals with disabilities.
- 2. Celebration Church Say No To Smoking project will educate African-American youth and adults about tobacco/vaping and cessation through community engagement and the Prevention Plus evidence-based program.
 3. JustLiving Advocacy, Inc. Wellness and YOU project will implement grassroots outreach efforts in Elkridge, Jessup, and Savage to educate community members about tobacco/vaping and cessation.

The grant seeks to engage community organizations in reducing health disparities related to chronic disease and COVID-19 infections in identified HOCO communities. RFP must address one of these objectives:

- Identify and recruit community leaders from identified communities to become certified Community Health Workers (CHWs)
- Support a network of Community Health
 Workers who are certified or plan to become
 certified to make referrals and outreach in
 identified communities.
