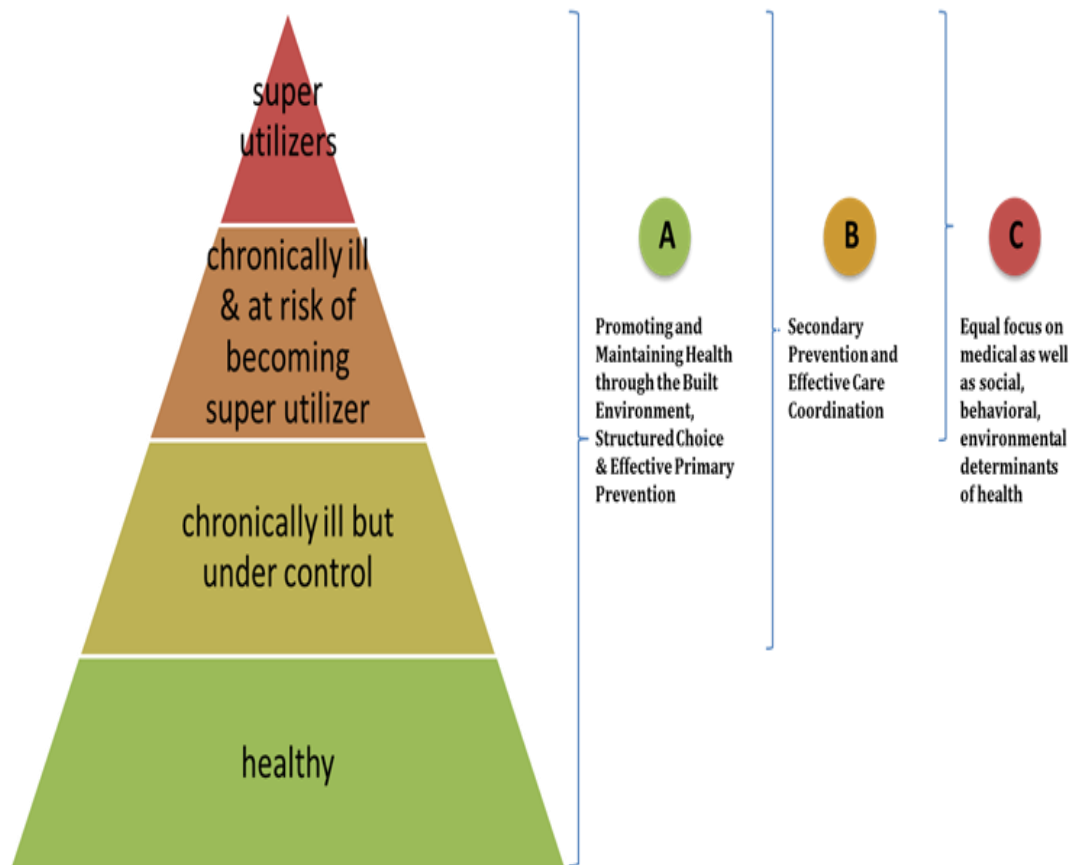
BUILD CAPACITY TO IMPROVE HEALTH OF HOWARD COUNTY RESIDENTS

- Changing the culture of health in congregations in Howard County
- Based on successful Memphis Model from Methodist LeBonheur Health System
- 22 congregations are currently engaged with J2BH (representing over 20,000 residents); 9 signed covenants
- Work with health ministry team, clergy, and lay leaders to promote common goals of J2BH
- Empowering residents to be in control of their health and their healthcare
- Funded by the Howard County Health Department
- Piloted this year in zip codes 21044 and 21045

SCREENINGS AND PREVENTION CLASSES

Journey to Better Health focuses primarily in the rising risk population by:

- Screening for hypertension, prediabetes, and obesity
- Offering free, evidence-based, self-management classes with the goal of preventing heart attacks, strokes, kidney failure, and type 2 diabetes



CARE, SUPPORT, AND SUSTAINABILITY

Member Care Support Network



- Volunteer Community Companions are trained to assist members in times of health need
- Companions provide help to address social determinants of health
- Congregations become a place to seek county resources through the Member Care Support Network
