The Parents' Place of **Maryland Presentation** & Discussion

Ms. Vicks provided a quick recap of the January Health Literacy Advisory Committee (HLAC) workgroup meeting. She then introduced Ms. Octavia Guthrie, The Parents' Place of Maryland (PPMD), to provide a presentation on her organization.

Ms. Guthrie provided an overview of PPMD and the services they provide Howard County community members. Highlighted Points include:

- PPMD is Maryland's Special Education and Health Information center.
- Local parent information centers can be found using the Parent Center Hub website.
- Services provided include:
 - One-on-one assistance to families
 - Resource sharing
 - **English and Spanish translations** available
 - **Topical trainings**
 - Leadership trainings
 - Military outreach
- **Baby LEADers**
 - Training for parents/guardians of children ages birth-5 whose child has a suspected or diagnosed developmental delay or disability
- **Guiding the Journey**
 - Training for parents/guardians of children ages 14-21 who have a disability or special MARYLAND - Home (biamd.org) healthcare need

Ms. Vicks inquired if there was information on PPMD that HCHD CHWs could hand out or share with the community members they work with. Ms. Guthrie mentioned that there is a one-pager available to be handed out in English and Spanish.
