	- Case and Local Examples	
	Ms. Stephanie Reid inquired about Safe Storage	
	locations in Howard County as she noticed there weren't	
	any displayed when viewing the Maryland Safe Storage	
	Map. She mentioned to the group that it may be	
	conducive for us to reach out to law enforcement to	
	further our safe gun storage efforts in HC.	
	Ms. Barbara Allen inquired on the usage of the safe	
	storage capacity, if people were going out of jurisdiction	
	to get guns removed from the home, if every jurisdiction	
	needs safe storage capacity, and is it accessible.	
	Ms. Janel Cubbage gave an overview of Jaelyn's Law,	
	essential a child access prevention law, and iterated that	
	states with stronger child access prevention laws have lower child suicide rates.	
	Ms. Barbara Allen inquired about treatment programs	
	requiring clients to turn over their SNAP/Food	
	Assistance cards. Mr. Jordan informed Ms. Allen that he	
	would connect her with Reena Rambharat to provide	
	insight on this issue if available.
