### **Health System Transformation**

- Realize the Triple Aim
  - 1. Improve the health of the population;
  - Enhance the patient experience of care;
  - 3. Reduce the per capita cost of care.
- Multidisciplinary teams, care coordination across settings, patientcentered care
- Population health model w/ initial focus on Medicare

### Progress Report: Core Work Event Notes



- "Luck of the draw"
- Portal for community resources to address social determinants
- Triggers to ID high utilizers & early-stage high utilizers
- HRA with social needs assessment view results across settings

### Progress Report: Core Work Event Notes



- Care coordination intervention & workforce based on risk profile
- Medical home buy-in from BOTH patient & provider
- Network "standards" (e.g. post-discharge visits, information sharing)
- Patient engagement & health literacy

- Scale CCT for initial target population

#### SNF

- Strategic collaboration HCGH, CIMS, Lorien, Gilchrist
- Care pathways and clinical protocols for top 2-3 conditions driving readmissions
- Care delivery models to support care coordination, prevent unnecessary utilization


