Felicia Pailen, MPH, Director of Assessment, Planning and Communications for the Howard County Health Department shared Howard County specific data on health outcomes and identified areas of health disparity with intersections such as age, race, income, etc.

Heidi Weiss-Beedie, Foreign-Born and Psychogeriatric Mental Health Services Coordinator, for the Howard County Health Department; Kim Eisenreich, Administrator Office of the Local Children's Board; and Jaqueline Douge, M.D. Co- Author, American Academy of Pediatrics Statement on Racism and Its Impact on Child and Adolescent Health; provided examples of local, state and national efforts to put equity into practice.

Presenters answered questions provided by the audience and offered strategies for continuing to engage the community in health equity practice.
