Ms. Christina Miller mentioned that she would share information on the support groups and programs the Claudia Mayer / Tina Broccolino Cancer Resource Center run so that can be added to CAREAPP.

Mr. Jordan gave an overview of the revamped chronic disease webpage on the LHIC website. The new website will feature links to access the chronic disease self-management resource guide, information on the Health Action Item at the time, and access to specific chronic disease resources/classes/programs.
