

The Bikeway Statistics

- 50 miles or 10% of the bike master plan
- \$9 million or 7% of the bike master plan
- 58% of the county's population lives within 1 mile of network
- 53% of all schools are located within 1 mile of network
- 56% of all parks are located within 1 mile of network
