Pat Gussio, of Health Care Access Maryland, informed the group that Open Enrollment is approaching. This year's enrollment window is truncated (in order to ensure coverage begins Jan 1<sup>st</sup>) and will run from Nov.1 – Dec. 15. It's important to spread this information to clients that may need insurance for the coming year, due to the window being half as long as it previously was. Sharon Hobson shared that the Health Department has applied to open two school-based wellness centers. One is at Deep Run Elementary and will be a Telemedicine program. The other is a traditional site at Wilde Lake High School. The approval visit took place August 28<sup>th</sup> with the hope of beginning at the start of the school year. Details regarding the approval will be shared as they become available.

Shanika Cooper informed the group that the Access to Care Department will begin outreach at the Detention Center, Parole and Corrections and the Patuxent Institute, to ensure those incarcerated are also getting access to necessary health services.

Anne Brinker reminded the group that the Community Action Council's full-day, fullyear head start and Pre-K programs are still accepting applicants and that CAC is offering energy assistance services. Organizations can refer clients to CAC if they need this service or send them to myDHR.
